BROWN HITS AIRWAVES FIRST IN CA-04

Launches Website, 2 Radio Ads

Roseville – This morning, the Brown for Congress campaign was first to hit the airwaves for the fall election season in the tightly contested race for the fourth Congressional District of California.

The Brown campaign launched two radio commercials, which will be running this week on various stations across the fourth district. Text of the ads are below and attached.

The first ad, entitled “Honor,” features former Senator Max Cleland, and highlights Charlie Brown’s lifelong record of service to his country in the Air Force.

The campaign also released the radio commercial “Corrupt or Ineffective” and a corresponding website www.corruptorineffective.com. The commercial and website highlight Rep. John Doolittle’s deep ties to the bribery scandals that have engulfed Congress and his ineffective leadership in working to solve our nation’s most pressing problems. Listeners are encouraged to go and review the website and then decide for themselves whether Rep. Doolittle is corrupt or simply ineffective.
